WHEREAS: We all need to listen to others; and


WHEREAS: Listening is the key to the successful cooperation of all persons for the survival of our society;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 11 to be


