



## Proclamation


- WHEREAS: The citizens of Minnesota and the citizens of Norway share vast cultural, historical and social traditions; and
- WHEREAS: The young men and women of the Norwegian Home Guard now training in Minnesota are representatives of the Norwegian people and Norwegian government; and

in Minnesota and call upon all citizens of our State to welcome and honor these young men and women of Norway.


