The Marvelous Minnesota Woman Award honors women for their personal accomplishments and acknowledges the significance of each individual's contribution to the community;

WHEREAS:

Phyllis Kahn of Minneapolis, has an outstanding record of accomplishment as a state legislator with a deserved reputation as a champion for women's athletics, non-smokers' rights, enfironmental issues and as a tough minded Appropriations Committee member and State Departments Division Chair; and

Phyllis Kahn earned a Doctorate degree from Princeton and has taught at the University of Minnesota in addition to family and legislative duties, and has recently been named Honorary Game Warden by the State Department of Natural Resources;
