WHEREAS: The Marvelous Minnesota Woman Award honors women for their personal accomplishments and acknowledges the significance of each individual's contribution to the community; and

WHEREAS: Ruth Myers, of Duluth, a member of the Grand Portage Band of Chippewa Indians, Minnesota, has a personal and professional commitment to Native American interests in education, health, history, and human rights as evidenced by the boards, committees and task forces on which she has served on the local, state and national levels, and the pride and respect she has fostered within her home as an enduring gift to her children;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

to be a 1988 Marvelous Minnesota Woman Award recipient.
