

ORDER PROVIDING ADDITIONAL PROTECTION FOR QUAIL, McLEOD COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of Game and Fish of the Minnesota Department of Conservation, has investigated the necessity of providing additional protection for quail and has found that this species is in danger of undue depletion,

THEREFORE, I, Theodore Christianson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to authority vested in me by Section 5640, S. C. 1923, do hereby order that no quail be taken or killed in McLeod County, Minnesota, during the years 1927 and 1928.

This order shall remain in force until the close of the 1929 regular session of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, unless sooner revoked or modified.
