Dear Mr. Hill:

The Minnesota Municipal Board has now processed the above ordinance. As you know, Ordinance #181 was adopted by the city council on April 5, 1978. However, it was not forwarded to the board for filing until August, 1987. It appears since passage of the ordinance that the property in question has been treated by all concerned as having been duly annexed by the city. Since the ordinance and attached documents, including the petition for annexation and waiver by Milaca Township stating they have no objections to the annexation, appear to otherwise generally satisfy the applicable statutory requirements relative to the annexation in question; and since the failure to file the ordinance with the board in a timely fashion appears to have simply been an oversight, the board is filing and approving the ordinance at this time in the absence of any information to suggest any prejudice to concerned parties as a result of such action.

According to law, this annexation ordinance must be filed with the Township Clerk, County Auditor, Secretary of State, and the Municipal Board. (Since the ordinance has already been filed with the Municipal Board, no additional copies are required.) We also recommend if you have not done so already, that you file the ordinance with the County Recorder.

The annexation is final upon the date the ordinance is approved by the Board, which is the date of this letter.

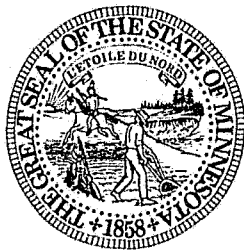

ORDINANCE NO. 181

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MILACA, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS, ALL BEING IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) OF SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 38, RANGE 27, MILLE LACS COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated March 13, 1978, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 13th day of March, 1978; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 9.32 acres, more or less, of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village, or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by the sole owner of all of said premises; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits at the north boundary thereof;

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILACA, MINNESOTA, ORDAINS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines

- (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the city and of the territory affected;
- (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the city limits and is urban or suburban in character; and
- (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village, or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The South 710.0 feet of the West 697.60 feet of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-four (24), Township Thirty-eight (38) North, Range Twenty-Seven (27) West, less and excepting therefrom the South 210.00 feet of the West 425.0 feet and also excepting the South 10.0 feet to public street, containing 9.32 acres, more or less.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the Mille Lacs County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
