

Proclamation

WHEREAS: The first air traffic control facility in Minnesota opened at the Minneapolis St. Paul

Airport on February 1, 1942; and

WHEREAS: The Air Traffic Control Center was relocated to Farmington, Minnesota, on July 1, 1962;

and

WHEREAS: Commercial and civil aviation continues to expand yearly; and

WHEREAS: Today is the beginning of a new era in air traffic control automation in Minnesota; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the fifteenth day of April to be

AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL DAY

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eightyeight, and of the State the one hundred thirtieth.
