



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The 1988 Spring Conference of the American Business Women's Association will be held in St. Paul, Minnesota, on May 20, 21, 22, 1988; and

WHEREAS: The mission of the American Business Women's Association is to bring together business women of diverse backgrounds, and to provide opportunities for them to help themselves and others grow personally and professionally through leadership, education, networking support, and national recognition; and

WHEREAS: There are more than 112,000 active members in over 2,100 chapters of this organization throughout the country; and

WHEREAS: Chapters throughout Minnesota sponsor local educational scholarships annually and join with other chapters throughout the United States in providing scholarships totaling more than three million dollars per year;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period May 15-22, 1988, to be
