WHEREAS: The tourism industry is extremely important to the State of Minnesota, contributing to our employment, economic prosperity, and international trade and understanding; and

WHEREAS: Each of us benefits from the effects of tourism in Minnesota, as it substantially enhances our personal growth and education, while promoting intercultural understanding and appreciation of the geography, history, and people of the state; and

WHEREAS: Personal incomes and leisure increase more rapidly with economic growth, therefore tourism can be expected to play an even greater role in the lives of the people of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: In recognition of the significance of the tourism industry to the enhancement of trade, understanding, and goodwill to the State of Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 15, 1988 to be
