WHEREAS: The goal of these walkers is to travel 25 kilometers in hopes that someday all of America's babies will be born healthy and happy; and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, April 24, 1988 to be

in Minnesota.


