

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF

WHEREAS, the Honorable Paul Kimball, Jr., Judge of District Court, Third Judicial District, State of Minnesota, has submitted his written application for retirement, by letter dated April 12, 1988, requesting that said retirement be made effective October 31, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the said Honorable Paul E. Kimball, Jr. has served as Judge of Probate and Juvenile Court since April 1, 1954; and Judge of District Court since June 13, 1984; and

WHEREAS, the said Honorable Paul Kimball, Jr. has satisfied the necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes Sections 490.121 to 490.132 for such retirement at the close of business on October 31, 1988.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RUDY PERPICH, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Paul Kimball, Jr., Judge of District Court, Third Judicial District, State of Minnesota, said retirement to be made effective on October 31, 1988. He shall become entitled thereafter to such retirement compensation provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 490. I hereby direct that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
