Scott, Auditor of the County of Hennepin, State of Minnesota, do hereby certify that at a special village election held at Orono Town Hall in the Village of Long Lake, in said County and State on the 17th day of April, 1906, "to vote on the question whether said village of Long Lake shall continue to be a part of the election district of the Town of Orono, or shall become a separate election district", the following number of votes were cast for and against said proposition as shown by the certificate of the village recorder of said village filed in my office on the 20th day of April, 1906, to-wit:
