



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The future of our great state resides with its children and the Minneapolis Crisis Nursery helps keep those children safe from potential harm; and

WHEREAS: Nearly four thousand children have used the Crisis Nursery since its opening five years ago today; and

WHEREAS: Hundreds of volunteers from dozens of communities have given 22,556 hours of service to the Nursery in its five years; and

WHEREAS: On May 1, 1983 the first crisis nursery in the state opened in Minneapolis and today is still dedicated to preventing child abuse;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the first week of May to be

MINNEAPOLIS CRISIS NURSERY WEEK

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twelfth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-eight, and of the State the one hundred thirtieth.
