WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is concerned about the health and well-being of its people, and it is appropriate that we recognize the many contributions made to the health of our citizens by Nurse Practitioners and by the faculty that prepares them; and

WHEREAS: These Nurse Practitioners serve our people by providing accessible, personalized primary care services which promote a high level of wellness in individuals and families of all ages; and

WHEREAS: Primary care services are provided in manner that encourages early detection and prompt treatment of disease and prevention of injury, and assists patients with chronic illness to live with disability and to die with dignity; and

WHEREAS: These Nurse Practitioners have promoted positive health behaviors through teaching, counseling and the provision of emotional support; and

WHEREAS: These Nurse Practitioners have, through their awareness of the interrelatedness of community, family and individual health, provide leadership in the provision and coordination of personal health services of our people;
