WHEREAS: The nostalgia of the river business dates back to Mark Twain, the packet boats and the big sternwheelers; and

WHEREAS: Many cities and towns in the State of Minnesota owe their origin to the Mississippi River system because this waterway is navigable to their shores; and

WHEREAS: The citizens of Minnesota have a renewed appreciation of what the Mississippi River means to them for recreation, natural beauty, conservation and river commerce;
