WHEREAS: This time and money benefits child transplant patients, senior citizens, disabled persons, the environment, and the economy of communities throughout Minnesota;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 24, 1988 to be

in Minnesota.


