WHEREAS: All persons can benefit by professional financial advice and informed decisions about life insurance; and


WHEREAS: The Minnesota Association of Life Underwriters is cooperating in a program to inform the public of the many and varied aspects of life insurance and life underwriting;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 25, 1988 to be

in Minnesota.


