WHEREAS: The efforts of Record Management professionals in making vast bodies of information more accessible to those who need it is of benefit to all our citizens; and


WHEREAS: The Twin Cities Chapter of the International Association of Records Managers and Administrators is holding its annual Spring Conference April 27 and 28; and



in Minnesota.


