Minnesota is a nighly developed state pioneered by its hardy forefathers, and each WHEREAS:

generation in turn has made significant contributions to aid the following generations;

and

WHEREAS: Minnesota has made great progress in the fields of medicine, engineering, and other

areas with a view toward the betterment of mankind; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota proudly recognizes that each nation and ethnic group has made great progress

and shared this progress with all mankind;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the twenty-fourth day of October to be

DIGNITY OF MANKIND DAY

in Minnesota and urge all citizens to be supportive of their fellow men and sensitive to their needs and let us invite all nations of the world to share with us in Mankind's recognition of its dignity.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-sixth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-eight, and of the State the one hundred thirtieth.
