WHEREAS: In 1973, a group of Twin Cities residents joined forces to form Fresh Air, Incorporated, a non-profit corporation dedicated to providing media access to members of the community; and

WHEREAS: "Fresh Air Radio," KFAI-FM, began broadcasting its diverse schedule of music, news and information to the Twin Cities on May 1, 1978; and

WHEREAS: Fresh Air, Incorporated, provides training and radio access to hundreds of volunteers from the community at large; and

WHEREAS: Fresh Air Radio informs, challenges and entertains its listeners through programming that meets the needs of persons under-represented in other media;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the first week of May to be

FRESH AIR RADIO WEEK

in Minnesota.
