



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota and the Minnesota Trade Office regard the People's Republic of China as a major trading partner; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is committed to establishing a long-term economic partnership with China; and

WHEREAS: Vice-Premier Tian Jiyun of the People's Republic of China will conduct a state visit to Minnesota from May 13 to May 15; and

WHEREAS: A delegation of members of China's State Economic Commission will explore ways to expand economic ties with Minnesota during a visit from May 18 to May 21; and

WHEREAS: A major US-PRC trade conference will be held in St. Paul on May 20;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May, 1988 to be

PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA MONTH

in Minnesota.
