WHEREAS: It is central to the mission of the Science Museum of Minnesota to stimulate scientific interest and inquiry in our young people; and

WHEREAS: The Science Museum of Minnesota has established an annual Achievement Awards Program; to promote science in Minnesota by spotlighting individuals engaged in scientific endeavors; to recognize economic growth in the State fostered by those who translate the discoveries of scientific exploration into productive, profitable businesses; and to encourage the study of science and the pursuit of careers in science; and
