

WHEREAS: Tobies Restaurant in Hinckley, Minnesota has been the favorite stop for travelors driving through northern Minnesota on Interstate Highway 35, since 1948, as the smell of brewing coffee and fresh baked goods from the coffee shop tures them from their cars; and

WHEREAS: Tobies has grown into a popular tourist spot, with an ice cream shop serving old fashioned ice cream, a restaurant with a complete menu, a lounge providing live entertainment, Tobies Americ-Inn Motor Hotel and the new Tobles Mill which provides boardwalk shopping with an 1800 s theme; and

WHEREAS: On May 28, 1988, a ribbon-cutting ceremony will be held at Tobies, the site of the Mission Creek 1894 Theme Park, which will be a recreation of the City of Hinckley as it was in 1894; and

WIIEREAS: Mission Creek 1894 Theme Park promises to be one of Minnesota's largest tourist attractions, and will portray our historic heritage, including the colorful past of settlers, lumberjacks and the American Indian, and will highlight a 1909 Steam Train, which will bring visitors to and from the park; and

WHEREAS; A 10,000 seat amphitheatre will stage a production of the "Great Hinckley Fire" by local theatre groups and townspeople, with other events planned throughout the season; and

WHEREAS: The history of Hinckley plays an important role in minnesota's history, and this authentic village, with its costumed residents, crafts and entertainment, will be a historic, educational and exciting place to visit;
