WHEREAS: Christina Berenberg's efforts to appropriately commemorate Israel's 40th Anniversary will be remembered as one of the best organizational efforts in the history of our state; and

WHEREAS: Working with the Minneapolis Federation for Jewish Services, the St. Paul United Jewish Fund and Council and the Jewish Community Council Anti-Defamation League, Christina coordinated a celebration which culminated on April 24, 1988 with 15,000 persons of all religious faiths and political persuasions expressing tribute to democracy and freedom; and
