WHEREAS: The National Federation of Music Clubs, and its affiliate, the Minnesota Federation of Music Clubs, join forces to direct attention to the dynamic influence of music in everyday living; and

WHEREAS: The National Music Week in its annual observance, desires to focus the attention of the public on music; as a dynamic means of communication between all people; as a channel of personal expression and as a forcible instrument for arousing, training and governing the minds and spirits of men;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 1-8, 1988 to be

in Minnesota and urge all citizens of our state to join in the observance and share the joy of music.
