

STATE OF MINNESOTA ENECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

GOVERNOR'S ORDER NO. 3, EXTENDING ADDITIONAL PROTECTION TO BULLHEADS IN OTTERTAIL AND BECKER COUNTIES.

Whereas, it has been represented to the Game and Fish Commissioner that bullheads are in danger of undue depletion in the waters of Ottertail and Secker counties, State of Minnesota, and

has presented me with the results of his investigation, and has recommended that additional protection be given buildheads in the above named counties to prevent their undue depletion,

Now, Therefore, I, Theodore Christianson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of and pursuant to authority vested in me by Section 134, Chapter 400, S.L. Winnesota 1919, (Sec. 5640 G.S. 1933), do hereby order that no bullheads taken from the waters of the counties of Ottertail and Becker, in the State of Minnesota, during the years 1937 and 1928, in any manner, may be taken for commercial purposes, or bought, sold or transported for such purposes, except when deemed necessary and advisable by the Game and Fish Commissioner, when, after investigation, he finds that any of the conditions set forth in Section 5605, G.S.1933, exist; when such bullheads may be fished for commercial purposes under the rules and regulations prescribed by the Commissioner of Game and Fish.

This order shall remain in force until the close of the 1929 regular session of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota unless sooner revoked or modified.


