



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Dr. Leland B. Sateren, conductor of the Sateren Choir, directed the Augsburg College Choir from 1950 until his retirement in 1979; and
- WHEREAS: Augsburg College, its students, faculty, staff and alumni, have strong ties to Norway; and
- WHEREAS: The Sateren Choir is composed primarily of Augsburg Choir alumni, many of whom also have strong ties to Norway; and
- WHEREAS: King Olav of Norway has conferred upon Dr. Sateren the St. Olaf Medal for his contribution to Norwegian music in the United States; and
- WHEREAS: The Sateren Choir will tour and perform in towns and cities throughout Norway from June 10 through June 27, 1988; and
- WHEREAS: The members and conductor of the Sateren Choir are designated goodwill ambassadors from the State of Minnesota to Norway from June 10 through June 27, 1988;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 28, 1988 to be
