GOODSSELL, Clerk of the Village of Tintah, in said County of Traverse and State of Minnesota, do hereby certify that at the Special Village Election, held in said Village on the 18th day of April, 1906, at which the question was plainly submitted "Whether such Village of Tintah should become a separate election district; the result was declared to be in favor of such Village becoming a separate election district, and that on the 19th day of April the Village Council met as a Canvassing Board and duly canvassed the returns of said election, and having found that thirty two votes had been cast in favor of such village becoming a separate election district and sixteen votes cast against such village becoming a separate election district, the Council then declared the result of said election to be in favor of such Village becoming a separate election district.


