



FINDINGS OF FACT
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW
AND ORDER

On May 18, 1987, the Minnesota Municipal Board received a petition by all of the property owners for the detachment of certain land from the City of Gilbert. A resolution for the detachment of the same land was received from the City of Gilbert on the 24th day of April, 1987.

On August 25, 1987, the Minnesota Municipal Board received an amended petition by all of the property owners for the detachment of certain land from the City of Gilbert. An amended resolution for the detachment of the same land was received from the City of Gilbert on the 9th day of May, 1988.

After review of the petition and resolution, the Minnesota Municipal Board hereby makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That a petition ~~and an amended petition was were~~ duly filed with the Municipal Board by the requisite number of property owners and a resolution ~~and an amended resolution~~ for the detachment of the same property ~~was were~~ filed by the City of Gilbert.

2. The petition and resolution contained all the information required by statute including a description of the territory proposed for detachment, which is as follows:

Government Lot 3, except the part South of the road shown on the plat of Cronin Beach, Section 34, Township 58, Range 17.

~~Lot 3, Cronin Beach (5.65 acres) Section 34, T58N, R17W.~~

3. The area proposed for detachment is situated within the City of Gilbert and is surrounded by Fayal Township.

4. The area proposed for detachment is approximately 5.65 acres.

5. The area proposed for detachment is rural in character and not developed for urban residential, commercial, or industrial purposes.

6. The area proposed for detachment has no buildings located on it.

7. There are no municipal improvements on the area proposed for detachment.

8. There is no population in the area proposed for detachment.

9. The area abuts the Town of Fayal, St. Louis County.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Minnesota Municipal Board duly acquired and now has jurisdiction of the within proceeding.

2. The area subject to detachment is rural in character and not developed for urban residential, commercial, or industrial purposes.

3. The detachment would not unreasonably affect the symmetry of the detaching municipality, but would improve the boundaries of the city.

4. The remainder of the municipality can continue to carry on the functions of government without undue hardship.

5. An order should be issued by the Minnesota Municipal Board detaching the area described herein.

ORDER


1. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the property described herein in Findings


