



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: David A. Longanecker has been executive director of the Minnesota Higher Education Coordinating Board (HECB) for the past four years; and
- WHEREAS: On June 30, David Longanecker is leaving this position, where his leadership and effectiveness will be greatly missed, to become executive director of the Colorado Commission on Higher Education; and
- WHEREAS: While serving as executive director of the HECB, David Longanecker did much to advance educational opportunity and high quality education in the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: David Longanecker has shown strong support for meeting the needs of students, particularly by his leadership in support of increased financial aid—he lead the HECB in its successful efforts to broaden the financial aid programs for part-time students, to initiate operation of a new loan program for students ineligible for other financial assistance, and he helped design the Graduated Repayment Income Protection Program, in which loan repayments are based on the borrowers' incomes; and
- WHEREAS: David Longanecker lead the HECB in major policy studies on remedial education, graduate education, and teacher education; and
- WHEREAS: David Longanecker was recognized for his expertise and leadership in identifying, analyzing, and recommending good public policies; and
- WHEREAS: On June 15, 1988 the Higher Education Coordinating Board is honoring David Longanecker for his many outstanding contributions, his hard work and his dedication to education and students in the State of Minnesota;
