WHEREAS: The Forest Lake City Marching Band is recognized as Minnesota's Adult Marching Ambassadors of Music; and

WHEREAS: The Forest Lake City Marching Band is a six-time state, four-time midwestern states and one-time national champion; and

WHEREAS: The Forest Lake City Marching Band is regarded as America's most honored independent marching band; and

WHEREAS: More than 220 adults, representing 50 communities in Minnesota have been members since the band's formation in 1981; and

WHEREAS: On July 4, 1988 the Forest Lake City Marching Band will make its 50th parade appearance;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the fourth day of July, 1988 to be

FOREST LAKE CITY MARCHING BAND DAY

in Minnesota in honor of its 50th performance.
