AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A PORTION OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER (NW%) OF SECTION THIRTY (30), TOWNSHIP FORTY-ONE (41), RANGE TWENTY (20) AND A PORTION OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE%) OF SECTION TWENTY-FIVE (25), TOWNSHIP FORTY-ONE (41), RANGE TWENTY-ONE (21), PINE COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO THE CITY OF HINCKLEY

The City Council of the City of Hinckley ordains:

SECTION 1. WHEREAS, Leslie Irons and Margaret Irons, Husband and Wife, are the owners of the following described premises located in the County of Pine, State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

The South five hundred (500) feet of the West five hundred eighty (580) feet of the North Half of Southwest Quarter of Northwest Quarter ( $N\frac{1}{2}$  of  $SW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty (30), Township Forty-one (41), Range Twenty (20), Pine County, Minnesota.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A PORTION OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE%) OF SECTION TWENTY-FIVE (25), TOWNSHIP FORTY-ONE (41), RANGE TWENTY-ONE (21), PINE COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO THE CITY OF HINCKLEY

The City Council of the City of Hinckley ordains:

SECTION 1. WHEREAS, Dorothy Von Rueden is the owner of the following described premises located in the County of Pine, State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

That part of the Northeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter (NE% of NE%) of Section Twenty-five (25), Township Forty-one (41), Range 21, Pine County, Minnesota, described as follows, towit:

Beginning at a point 217 feet East of the Northwest corner of said NE¼ of NE¼; thence South and parallel with the west boundary line of said NE¼ of NE¾ a distance of 24 rods; thence West and parallel with the North boundary line of said NE¼ of NE¾ to the West boundary line of said NE¾ of NE¾; thence South over and along the West boundary line of said NE¾ of NE¾; to the South boundary line of said NE¾ of NE¾; to the South boundary line of said NE¾ of NE¾; to the West right-of-way line of U.S. Interstate Highway #35; thence North along the West right-of-way line of Interstate Highway #35 to the North boundary line of said NE¾ of NE¾; thence West over and along the North boundary line of said NE¾ of NE¾ to the point of beginning.
