WHEREAS: Adult foster care is one of the oldest human services with roots that date as far back as 700 AD in Gheel, Belgium; and

WHEREAS: Adult foster homes provide care and support to many adults with special needs who would otherwise need to live in institutional settings; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota recognizes the contributions of adult foster homes in serving those who are vulnerable due to physical, emotional or mental disabilities; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota and counties in Minnesota are combining their efforts in an adult foster home recruitment campaign during the month of October 1988 using the theme "We're bulding Up the Home Team";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October to be
