AMERICAN CENTENARIAN DAY

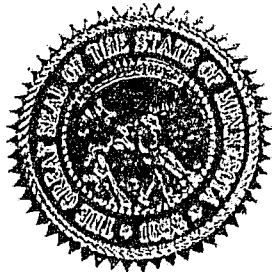
