

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE RESULT OF ELECTION IN THE VILLAGE OF  
MONTICELLO, IN THE COUNTY OF WRIGHT AND STATE OF MINNESOTA ON THE  
QUESTION OF REINCORPORATION UNDER THE REVISED LAWS OF ~~1905~~ 1906

Whereas the Village Council of the Village of Monticello in  
the County of Wright and State of Minnesota did by resolution  
order a special election in said village on the question whether  
said village should relinquish the general laws and special charter  
under which it had been organized and heretofore existed and thence-  
forth be governed by the provisions of the Revised Laws of 1905  
Chapter 9 relating to villages and said election was duly held  
on April 14th. 1906  
after due notice thereof and the returns thereof have been duly  
made and certified to this council,

Therefore BE IT RESOLVED by the Village Council of said Vil-  
lage of Monticello that a majority of the votes cast at said el-  
ection were in the affirmative and in favor of such reincorporation
