

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Elevated blood cholesterol levels are causally linked with coronary heart disease and stroke; and

WHEREAS: Coronary heart disease is the number one cause of death in the United States and approximately 500,000 Americans suffer strokes each year; and

WHEREAS: Approximately 25% of all adults are candidates for treatment of elevated cholesterol; and

WHEREAS: Awareness and education about blood cholesterol could help prevent coronary heart disease and stroke; and

WHEREAS: Riverside Medical Center and KSTP-TV are sponsoring a city-wide cholesterol screening September 10-17;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 10-17, 1988 to be

CHOLESTEROL AWARENESS WEEK

in Minnesota for the promotion of health.




