WHEREAS: The process of democratic governments are best served when fully visible and viewed unedited as they happen; and

WHEREAS: Community television has brought us live coverage of the Minnesota Senate and Hennepin County board meetings as well as many city council and school board meetings; and

WHEREAS: Community television brings the process of democratic government into our home, informing us and allowing us to participate;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October, 1988 to be
