Dr. Rollin M. Dennistoun is stepping down after a 43-year career dedicated to the service of agriculture in this state and beyond; and WHEREAS:

Doc Dennistoun is known far and wide as a lobbyist for agriculture, as a promoter of agriculture through his guidance of nine promotional councils, and as a champion of high standards, quality products and sound conservation as Deputy Commissioner of Agriculture in Minnesota; and WHEREAS:

Doc Dennistoun has a distinguished record as a knowledgeable, articulate spokesman for farm families, attained during his 24 years with the Minnesota Department of Agriculture; and WHEREAS:
