

Proclamation

WHEREAS: In 1968 George Nadler started a family-owned Arby's Restaurant franchise with one store in Richfield; and

WHEREAS: The family-owned business continued under the name of Franchise Associates, and now is the exclusive Arby's franchisee for the Twin Cities area; and

WHEREAS: Franchise Associates now has 35 stores throughout Minnesota and employs over 1,500 people; and

WHEREAS: Franchise Associates has been selected as the outstanding Arby's licensee among all franchises throughout the United States, and one of its stores was recently selected as one of the "best five" Arby's stores in the United States; and

WHEREAS: George Nadler is a major supporter of the Big Brothers and Big Sisters programs in Minnesota, and last year one of his Arby's restaurants hosted all Big Brothers and Big Sisters from throughout Minnesota at a Twins Game, and Arby's restaurants in the Twin Cities area held a promotion which raised \$10,000 for Big Brothers and Big Sisters;

WHEREAS: A formal dinner is being held to honor George Nadler on Saturday, August 13, 1988; and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 13, 1988 to be
