WHEREAS: Baseball bridges the age gap and is enjoyed by young and old alike; and

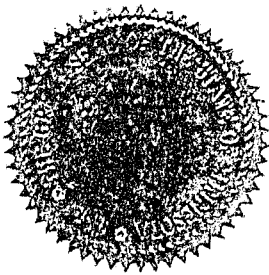
