WHEREAS: The livestock producers of Minnesota, in association with all diversified farmers, comprise a large and viable segment of the state's economy; and

WHEREAS: Red meat and dairy products as foods, are rich in protein plus essential vitamins and minerals, which makes them the foods to serve for many good reasons; and

WHEREAS: It is important that people of Minnesota, as well as the entire nation, recognize the importance of red meat and dairy products in every day life; and

WHEREAS: May is beef month and June is dairy month, and we recognize the efforts of the Minnesota Livestock Breeders Association to combine the forces of their organization with the American Dairy Association, and all producers, processors, and promotional organizations;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, June 22, 1988 to be

RED MEAT AND DAIRY PRODUCTS DAY

in Minnesota.
