WHEREAS: The Red Wing Community has made a commitment to excellent education for its youth and excellent service to its people;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

to be "Capitol For A Day" on July 25, 1988.


