WHEREAS: The St. Olaf Choir will, from August 17-23, represent the United States at the 1988 Seoul Olympic Arts Festival in Seoul, South Korea; and

WHEREAS: The St. Olaf Choir is the only United States representative in this prestigious pre-Olympic event; and

WHEREAS: The St. Olaf Choir continues a 76-year tradition of musical goodwill ambassadorship, spreading the name and fame of Minnesota throughout this nation and the world; and

WHEREAS: The St. Olaf Choir will again carry the banner of Minnesota abroad to an event which will attract worldwide attention; and

WHEREAS: The St. Olaf Choir is the only non-professional group selected, thus exemplifying the continuing excellence of Minnesota's many outstanding educational institutions in the nation's "education" state; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the St. Olaf Choir of St. Olaf College, Northfield, to be a cultural and educational representative of the State of Minnesota during its appearance at the 1988 Seoul Olympic Arts Festival, August 17-23, in Seoul, South Korea.
