



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The athletes of this nation are among its most valuable human resources, representing the highest goals of individual achievement and competitive excellence; and

WHEREAS: The U.S. Congress has authorized the production and sale of two commemorative coins—a five-dollar gold coin and a \$1 silver coin—honoring U.S. participation in the 1988 Olympic Games; and

WHEREAS: The sale of the 1988 U.S. Olympic Coins is expected to raise more than \$40 million for the training of this nation's present and future athletes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 7-13, 1988 to be

U. S. OLYMPIC COIN WEEK

in Minnesota, to honor this nation's past, present, and future athletes and recognize the Olympic Coins as a unique means of honoring and supporting the Olympic movement in this nation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-eight, and of the State the one hundred thirtieth.
