The athletes of this nation are among its most valuable human resources, representing WHEREAS:

the highest goals of individual achievement and competitive excellence; and

The U.S. Congress has authorized the production and sale of two commemorative coins—a WHEREAS:

five-dollar gold coin and a \$1 silver coin-honoring U.S. participation in the 1988

Olympic Games; and

The sale of the 1988 U.S. Olympic Coins is expected to raise more than \$40 million for WHEREAS:

the training of this nation's present and future athletes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 7-13, 1988 to be

U.S. OLYMPIC COIN WEEK

in Minnesota, to honor this nation's past, present, and future athletes and recognize the Olympic Coins as a unique means of honoring and supporting the Olympic movement in this nation.
