

Wayzata April 23rd 1906
Reincorporation under the revised laws of 1905
State of Minnesota

Whereas the village Council of Wayzata did
on April 3rd 1906 by resolution duly adopted decide
to submit the question of reincorporation of said Village
to the voters of the village and in accordance with such
resolution caused five notices of said special election
to be posted five prominent places in said village
calling the election for April 17th 1906 and

Whereas on said date to wit April 17th 1906
the said election was duly held in proper and legal form
the result being as follows

Votes cast	Thirty	(30)
" " For reincorporation	Twenty	(20)
" " Against "	Ten	(10)
Majority for reincorporation	Ten	(10)

Therefore resolved that the village of Wayzata
surrender its charter of 1883 and stand reincorporated
under the revised laws of 1905 State of Minnesota
In accordance with the ~~provisions~~ provisions of Chapter
No 9 of said laws
