

Proclamation

The Church and Schools of Saint Agnes, celebrating a century of providing spiritual and educational guidance for the people of Minnesota are recognized as having been one of the largest parishes and parochial schools in the State of Minnesota, and the first parochial co-educational high school in the City of St. Paul; and WHEREAS:

Saint Agnes is one of only two parishes in the entire Twin Cities offering thirteen complete years of education, grades kindergarten through twelve; and WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: Saint Paul founder family names are found in the enrollment records and are now of the second, third and fourth generations presently at Saint Agnes; and

Saint Agnes, located at Thomas and Kent Streets, Saint Paul, is the center of Frogtown, and its towering spire of the Church is a landmark of the city and is recognized by the State Historical Society and listed with the National Register as the finest example of baroque architecture and a structure of significance to the State of Minnesota; and WHEREAS:

Monsignor Richard J. Schuler, Pastor of Saint Agnes, and his assistant, Reverend Michael Ince; William G. Peper, Principal of the High School; John E. Boone, Principal of the Grade School; Sister M. Celine Koktan, Mother Superior of the Convent; the Alumni Association of Saint Agnes; and all of the members of the school and parish organizations of Saint Agnes invite all to celebrate this festive and historic occasion of the Centennary of Saint Agnes on Saturday, the 3rd of September; WHEREAS:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 3, 1988 to be
