



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The safe transportation of Minnesota's school children should be a matter of concern for all citizens of the State; and

WHEREAS: The reduction of accidents requires awareness and consideration on the part of all motorists; and

WHEREAS: Over 600,000 students are transported to and from school each day in over 9,000 school buses in Minnesota which travel over 100 million miles each year; and

WHEREAS: Due to driver and student education programs, careful maintenance of buses and annual inspections conducted by the Minnesota State Patrol, pupil transportation in Minnesota has compiled an excellent safety record;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 18 to 24, 1988, to be

SCHOOL BUS SAFETY WEEK

in Minnesota.
