WHEREAS: On Friday, August 26th, a picnic is being held to celebrate the accomplishments and success of everyone involved in TEEN TEAMWORKS '88;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 26, 1988 to be

in Minnesota.


