WHEREAS: Organized labor has always led the fight to improve the lot of all American workers; and

WHEREAS: Labor organizations remain in the forefront of battles to protect consumer rights and secure justice and equality for all citizens; and

WHEREAS: Foreign goods have invaded our markets at a record rate; and

WHEREAS: We can protect the American economy by insisting on buying American made products; and

WHEREAS: Distinctive emblems of quality American craftsmanship and service are the Union Label, Shop Card, Store Card and Service Button; and

WHEREAS: The Union Label and Service Trades Department, AFL-CIO each year sponsors UNION LABEL WEEK to salute those hallmarks that are uniquely American;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 5-10, 1988 to be

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I call upon all citizens to make a concentrated effort to support the products and services identified by the Union Label, Shop Card, Store Card and Service Button.
